Official Rules

Theme □ Tell a *historia* of a person, place, event or your own experience in Latino culture.

Eligibility □ Students in grades 6 through 12

Specifications □ A signed and completed entry form for each entry must be submitted.

Written Composition □

- 300-500 words □
- Typewritten, double-spaced □
- Printed on 8 1/2" x 11" paper □
- English Language □
- Must be an original submission by a single author □
- (No multiple author submissions accepted) □

Documentary Video

- 2-5 minutes (TRT - Total Run Time)
- With or without audio*
- Color or Black & White
- Acceptable media: VHS, Hi-8, Digital 8, & miniDV
- (You may also submit on DVD)
- (Multiple collaborators are permitted)

Students may submit more than one entry.
A separate entry form is required for each work submitted.
Applicable waivers should be included as needed* (soon to be available from www.bronzescreen.net)
