# **HISTORIA Competition**



### **WHY is the contest being offered?**

The Bronze Screen - Historia Competition is an essay and documentary film competition encouraging students to document the Latino experience in words and images - empowering them to shape and tell stories important to them and their communities. It is a great way to inspire students to interpret their personal experiences.

### **WHO is this contest for?**

This unique scholarship competition is for students in grades 6 – 12 who are interested in documenting the Latino experience in words and images. Eligible students are invited to submit their entries either as written compositions or documentary videos.

### **WHAT does the contest involve?**

Students are invited to tell a story by selecting one of the following Latino themed categories:

1. A person of special significance to you (family, friend, or historical figure).
2. A meaningful place or location in Latino history.
3. A historical event from your community's past.
4. How Latino culture has directly impacted you.

#### **Written Composition**

300 - 500 words

Printed on 8 1/2" X 11" paper

English Language

Typewritten, double-spaced

Must be an original submission by a single author

No multiple author submissions accepted

#### **Documentary Video**

2-5 minutes (TRT - Total Run Time)

Color or Black and White

With or without audio

Acceptable media includes:

VHS, hi-8, Digital 8 and mini DV

May also submit on DVD

Multiple collaborators are permitted  
in the video competition

### **WHAT do contestants receive?**

Cash prizes and other valuable awards based on grade level will be presented. Winners will also be featured at the Bronze Screen website: [www.bronzescreen.net](http://www.bronzescreen.net).

### **WHEN is the deadline for submitting entries?**
